Explanation of Change:

NOTE: The effective date of the policy listed below has been delayed. We will notify providers of the new effective date as soon as possible.

Johns Hopkins Health Plans has released its notification of the following updated reimbursement policy:

(RPC.027) Injections and Infusions Policy - Updated

When injection and infusion services are rendered in an Ambulatory Infusion Center/Suite (AIC/AIS), providers are to bill as follows:

- Report services in POS II
- Append modifier SS on the claim line
- Report rending and referring provider

Infused drugs administered in an AIC/AIS do not qualify for exception to Medicare drug pricing (ASP plus 6%) since they are not being administered in a home setting (POS I2).

Unbundling injection and infusion services and supplies will result in a denial.

Appropriate documentation must support all codes billed in an AIC/AIS, or the service(s) will be denied.

In accordance with MDH and COMAR guidance, Priority Partners providers must be actively enrolled in ePREP*, when services are rendered.
