Effective Nov. I, 2024, Johns Hopkins Health Plans has approved the following changes to Prior Authorization (PA), No Prior Authorization (NPA) and Non-Covered (NC) requirements for the selected procedure codes listed below (see link) for Advantage MD, EHP, Priority Partners, and USFHP. These requirements affect members of all ages enrolled in these plans.
