## Who may be eligible?

- ◆ People between 25-50 years old
- ◆ You have a formal diagnosis of early Huntington's Disease (HD) or carry the abnormal huntingtin gene and are starting to show early signs of HD



## What will the study require?

- ◆ Clinic visits 3 times a year for approx. 2 years
- ◆ Clinic visits include spinal injections of the investigational drug or placebo
- ◆ A study companion to attend some clinic visits with you
  - ◆ Phone call check-ins between clinic visits
