Guidelines for Writing the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Essay

Applicants are requested to submit a Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Essay (typically around 500 words) providing your aspirations, experiences, and contributions as a caregiver, professional, or faith leader toward promoting diversity, equity, and inclusion in human relationships or communities.

In this essay, you are invited to share how your lived experiences and pastoral or professional activities have contributed to fostering inclusion and equity.

- Please be specific and include at least one concrete example from your professional or personal
 life. Examples may include providing care to someone, working with others, teaching and
 mentoring others, or leading in any capacity in ways that promote relationships and an
 environment where diversity is welcomed and celebrated and equity and inclusion are fostered.
- Please articulate what you have learned from this experience and what you found challenging.
